

MT Legislative Brief – Week of March 15, 2021

Things have been a little slow since transmittal, however, there was a hearing on **SB178** last week. This Bill would prevent the state from adopting sprinkler codes in single and two family dwellings. There was strong opposition from the fire service as well as the sprinkler industry as well as the insurance industry. The bill is awaiting executive action.

HB 627 is a bill that will have a hearing today that would provide \$10,000 funding for Type 3 AHIMT's out of the Governors Emergency fund. We will see where this goes.

HB 264 the 'new' move over law is still awaiting a hearing date in the Senate.
Things to watch:

LC0729 has some amended language and will probably get a bill number assigned soon. This Bill would require mill levies to be put back in front of the voters every ten years. The Fire Alliance will oppose this Bill!

LC 1946 would receive emergency services licensing laws, consolidating them all under the DPHHS.

SJ 22 would provide for an interim study of emergency medical service laws.
