

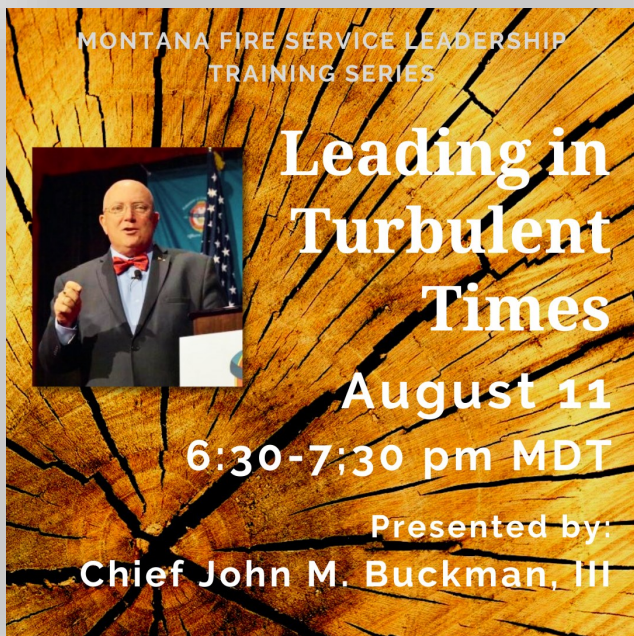
Montana Fire Service Leadership Training Series
